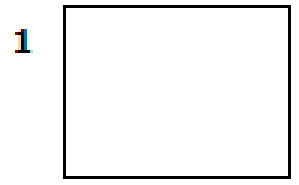
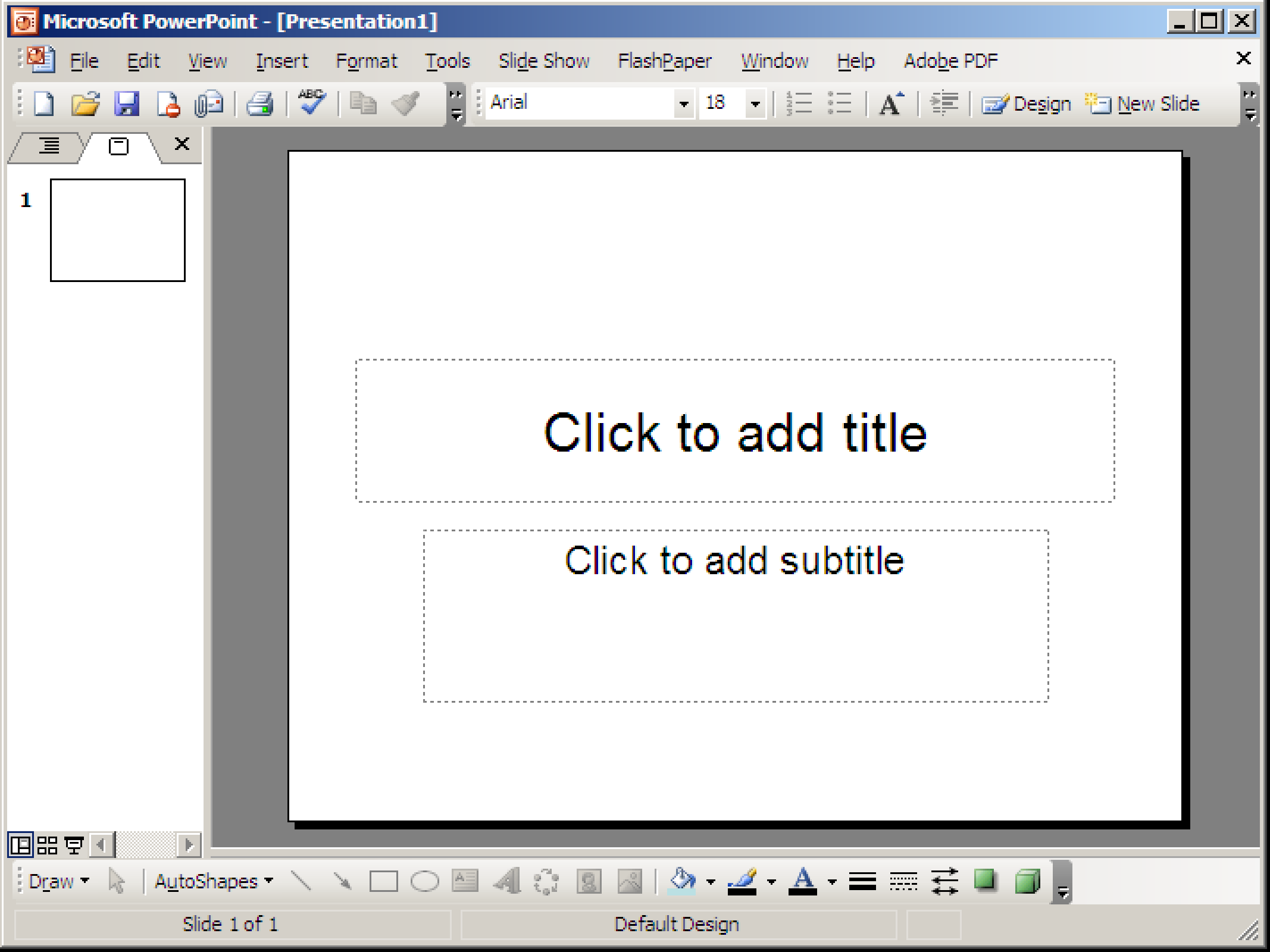
Text on slides

- Mayer et al, 2001
- Redundancy Effect
 - If there is information on a slide and the presenter says it, the audience is less likely to recall fact



TelePrompTer Effect

- Slides help presenters remember what to say
- When a slide is used in this manner, the presenter's back turns to the audience
- Turning one's back to the audience is a presentation faux pas
